Evanglism by Addition vs. Evanglism by Multiplication

If 100,000 missionaries¹ reached 500 people each, a little over 2% of the world's 2.2 billion unevangelized² would be reached.

If 100,000 missionaries equipped 44 church leaders who reach 500 people each, 100% of the world's 2.2 billion unevangelized would be reached.
