Marriage, Divorce, and Remarriage

I have been thinking about marriage a lot lately. Myra and I celebrate our 39th wedding anniversary on May 24th. We are preparing for Abby's (our sixth child) wedding for June 22nd. I am meeting with a couple who have asked me to perform their wedding at the end of September. My desire is to provide them with a biblical foundation for their marriage covenant.

There is one more reason I have been thinking about marriage: divorce. Divorce is becoming a growing issue in Rwanda and a diminishing concern in the U.S. Divorce has become a "normal" part of the American culture. However, the divorce rate is dropping in America due partly to the decrease in the marriage rate. According to Groucho Marx, "Marriage is the chief cause of divorce." The Barna Group reports that one-third of adults in the U.S. who have been married have also divorced at least once.

One of the growing concerns for church leaders in Rwanda is the increase in divorces (another sign of Western influence). These leaders usually take an extremely conservative view of divorce and remarriage. They shared the story of a man who wanted to get married. His wife divorced him and left him and the children for a life of prostitution. The Church is telling him that biblically he cannot marry someone else. However, in Matthew 19:9 Jesus says he can. This is one example of the confusion
