Frank and Theophile

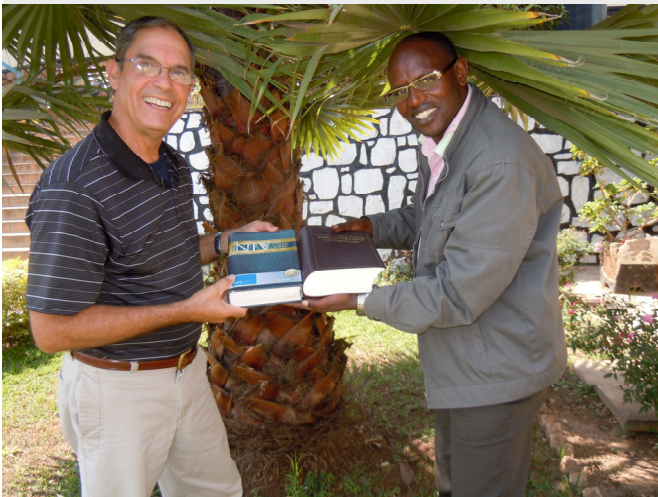
- Purchased a 1997 Land Cruiser for Rwanda Challenge
- Taught 95 church leaders in all five provinces in eight locations
- Slept in tents for twenty nights
- Provided 100 Kinyarwanda Study Bibles for church leaders
- Experienced three new open doors

- ◆ teach fifty church leaders from various denominations in the South Province
- ◆ teach twenty church leaders in the West Province in the oldest refugee camp in Rwanda
- ◆ teach church leaders and preach in the prisons in Rwanda

Instead of \$15,000, we were able to purchase this Toyota Land Cruiser for \$12,800. Without this vehicle RC pays \$2,500 +/- each trip for vehicle and driver.
