The Vision

The New Mission

The mission of Rwanda Challenge is an **affordable** associate degree in Bible/theology for Rwandan preachers to be awarded by September 10, 2023.

The new mission is Rwanda Challenge's response to new "Church" laws in Rwanda.

- A local church cannot meet without a legal building.
- A local church cannot meet without a legal preacher.
- A legal preacher is required to have an associate degree in Bible/theology by September 10, 2023.

These new laws create significant issues for the Church in Rwanda and Rwanda Challenge.

Prayer Requests (Phil. 1:9-11)

- Ask for wisdom and discernment in equipping Rwandan church leaders.
- Seek God for Mid-Atlantic Christian University
 as she prepares for application with the Higher
 Education Council to offer an associate degree in Rwanda.
- Ask God to provide the financial partners who will help MACU-Rwanda become a reality.

New Laws — The Main Issues

Because of new laws in Rwanda, RC and church leaders are facing new issues. Here are the main ones.

- A preacher will need an associate degree in Bible/religion by September 11, 2023 to be legal.
- A local church cannot exist without a legal preacher and building.
- The associate degree must be awarded by an accredited institution (recognized internationally).
- A student must have a high school diploma (or equivalent) to begin studies toward an associate degree.
- Students must be proficient in English.
- Most preachers in Rwanda are not proficient in English and do not have a high school diploma.
- Higher education is not affordable for most Rwandans.
- A higher education degree offered in Rwanda requires a physical address (property and appropriate building, etc.) in Rwanda; approved by the Higher Education Council.

Some Implications

- A large percentage of existing preachers will no longer be legal on September 11, 2023.
- Thus, a large percentage of existing churches will no longer be legal on September 11, 2023.
- Many existing preachers will need to be replaced by a legal preacher by September 11, 2023.



Three Potential Students for MACU-Rwanda.

Moses, Eric, and Jean Claude represent thousands of young people in Rwanda who love the Church, desire to serve, but cannot afford an associate degree to meet the requirement of the new Rwandan law.

Rwanda Challenge is pursuing a plan which will not only provide legal preachers by September 2023, but will prepare young people to lead the Church in Rwanda for decades to come.

A Potential Building



This unfinished building would cost us about \$175,000. The plan is to rent the six units on the street level to businesses, creating a sustainable path for overhead expenses of MACU-Rwanda.
