Update on Volcano Relief

In May, while we were in Rwanda, Mt. Nyiragongo, in neighboring Democratic Republic of the Congo, erupted without much warning. Probably worse than the eruption were the earthquakes that followed over the course of about two weeks. Several 4.5+ magnitude quakes in a row were felt in Kigali, which is about sixty miles southeast of the affected region. While some of those tremors were merely unnerving for us, they damaged hundreds of homes on both sides of the border nearer the epicenter.

Rwanda Challenge partnered with International Disaster Emergency Services (ides.org) to assist victims of this disaster. IDES provided a grant to be distributed by RC. Theophile Rugubira, Rwanda Director of RC, coordinated efforts in Rwanda with the assistance of church leaders from among the Harvest Christian Churches. A one-month supply of food, kitchen utensils, bedsheets/blankets, water cans, and Bibles were distributed to sixty-four families in Rwanda and the Democratic Republic of the Congo. This relief effort was completed in early November.

Theophile reported, "It was such a blessing to assist victims of the volcano eruption. They were overwhelmed by Jesus' love to receive the different items. One lady told she is now 'sleeping in heaven' (as) she never (had) such bedsheets and blankets in her life. She is 54 years old. I was so excited to represent IDES and give the support to families." Please continue to pray for our brothers and sisters in Christ who have been impacted by this natural disaster, as they recover and rebuild.

RC counts it a blessing to partner with IDES and the Church in Rwanda to relieve some of the suffering in our world.

Three Updates

MACU-Rwanda Campus

RC tried to purchase the building and property for the MACU-Rwanda campus in January 2021. The primary business owner was going through a divorce and the court held up the sale. Due to two court delays and the court being closed because of Covid, we now expect the court to approve the sale of the building on January 17, 2022.

Lord willing, we will purchase the building in January. Then RC will need to finish the building and get occupancy. The last estimate was \$110,000 to finish the building, of which we have about half. Once we get occupancy, we can rent the street level units to businesses to cover overhead costs of running the campus.

The final steps will be to furnish the campus and launch our first class on-campus.
